The following is an outline of the earliest branches of the Plaskett family for which I have found records, that can be linked to the William Lucas Plaskett family of California.

I. John Plasket of Philadelphia, b. m. October, 1733 to Phebe Biles of Philadelphia, in Quaker meeting.

II. William Plasket of Trenton, N.J., b. ¹⁷¹⁷ m. 8 mo., 9th, 1734, Margaret Lucas Margerum, widow, in Falls Monthly Quaker meeting. d. May 14, 1748, Trenton, New Jersey. ~~1740~~

A. William Plasket, b. m. prior to 1 mo., 1775, at which Chesterfield Mo. Mtg., it is noted, "William Plascot hath married and neglects to make satisfaction. Committee appointed to visit him." Mo. Mtg. held 6 mo., 1, 1775, "William Plascott is training and bearing arms. The meeting releases him from membership with Friends."

1. William Plasket, b. 1780, m. as second wife, August 3, 1819, Eliza Holly [b. 1799]. d. 1854, Bethlehem, Indiana.

a. The 1830 census indicates there were 8 children at this time; 5 males and 3 females, 4 by an earlier marriage, as 2 males and 1 female were between 20 & 30, and 1 male was between 15 & 20. The other children were 1 male between 5 & 10, 1 male under 5, and 2 females between 5 & 10.

b. Amanda Plasket, b. 1835, only child still at home, recorded on 1850 census, Clark Co., Indiana.
